## Heading Out for Deputation, But the Work Goes On!

It is amazing that our term is already over and we are about to head back to the USA for a year of deputation, visiting churches, and raising support for our next four years back in Cambodia. While we are back in the States, many of the projects we are working on will continue to move forward.

The Nara and Grandpa Choy radio program will be being broadcast twice each week over a local FM station that reaches over half the country's population. At the same time, the corresponding Sunday school curriculum will be tested in a number of churches across the country.

The Cambodia Community Bible Institute will also continue to provide distance education in remote areas. CCBI is in the midst of many transitions. But the need for continued training and discipleship in rural Cambodian churches continues to grow, and CCBI is making the changes necessary to be as effective as possible.

We are excited about having the opportunity to share what God has been doing with churches in the USA and we are excited to share what God has put on our hearts for the future as well. We hope to see you all soon, and please pray that God would bless our time in the States and bring us back to Cambodia soon!
